The KnowRISK project website is available online at www.knowriskproject.com and is available in four languages: English, Portuguese, Italian and Icelandic.

The website is structured as follows:

- A Public area, that will serve the purpose of a publicly available source of news on the project, information on meetings and conferences (News & Events section), provides downloadable material of education/learning, advices, the RiskMAP's, the Practical guide and Portfolio and lessons learned from successful experiences of risk mitigation; and access to the project public deliverables and documents. It also provides specific pages to target public, namely schools, citizens and stakeholders.

- A Private area, accessible for registered users only (project partners), where documents and restricted deliverables can be uploaded, updated and searched according to specific tags.

These two areas are described through screenshots in the following sections.

1.2.1. Portal structure and content

The KnowRISK public area is aimed at a dissemination of KnowRISK, consortium, objectives, expected impacts and main achieved results.

1.2.1.1 Home page

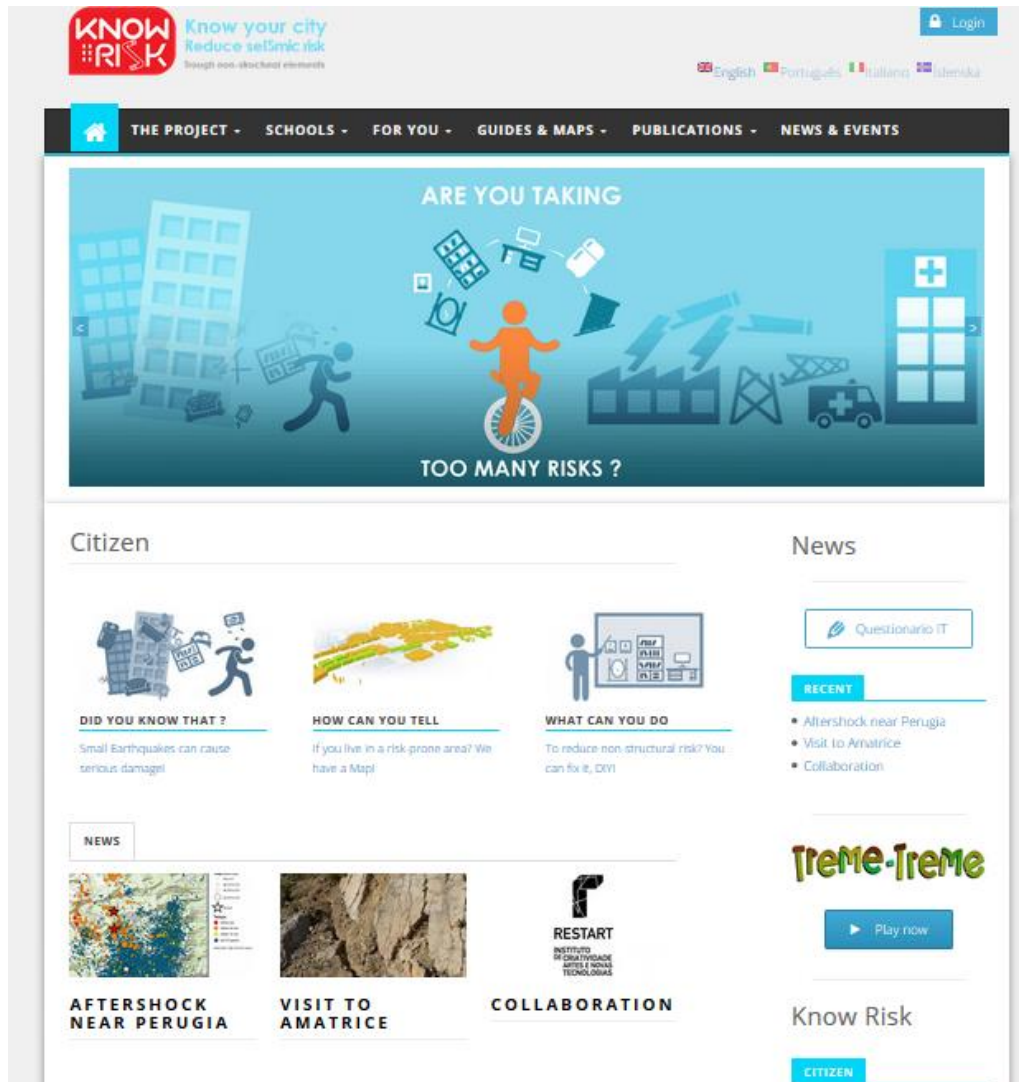


Figure 1. Homepage

Figure 1 shows the Homepage of the KnowRISK project website, is the start page used to facilitate navigation to other pages on the site.

- KnowRISK structure

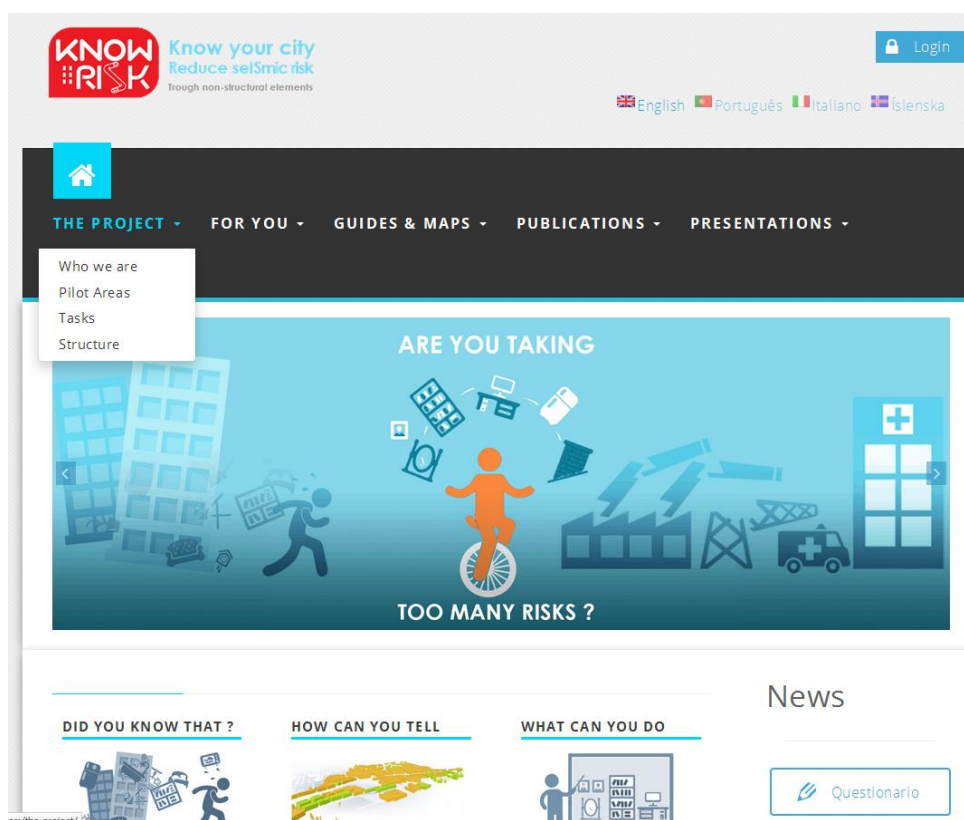


Figure 2. Project description

- Treme-Treme game

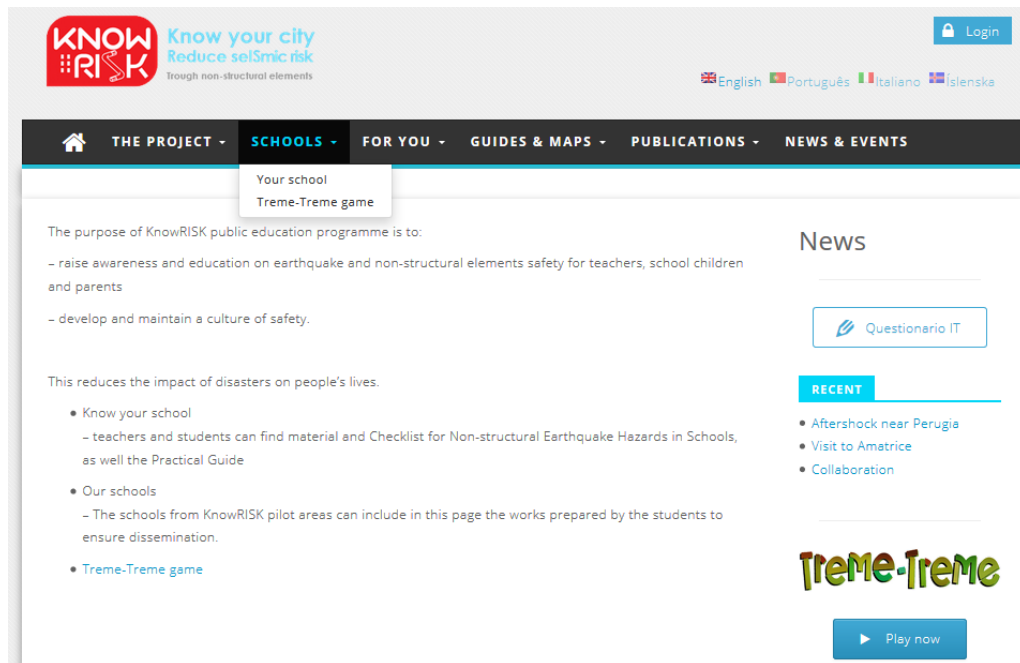


Figure 3. Schools page

1.2.1.4 For You

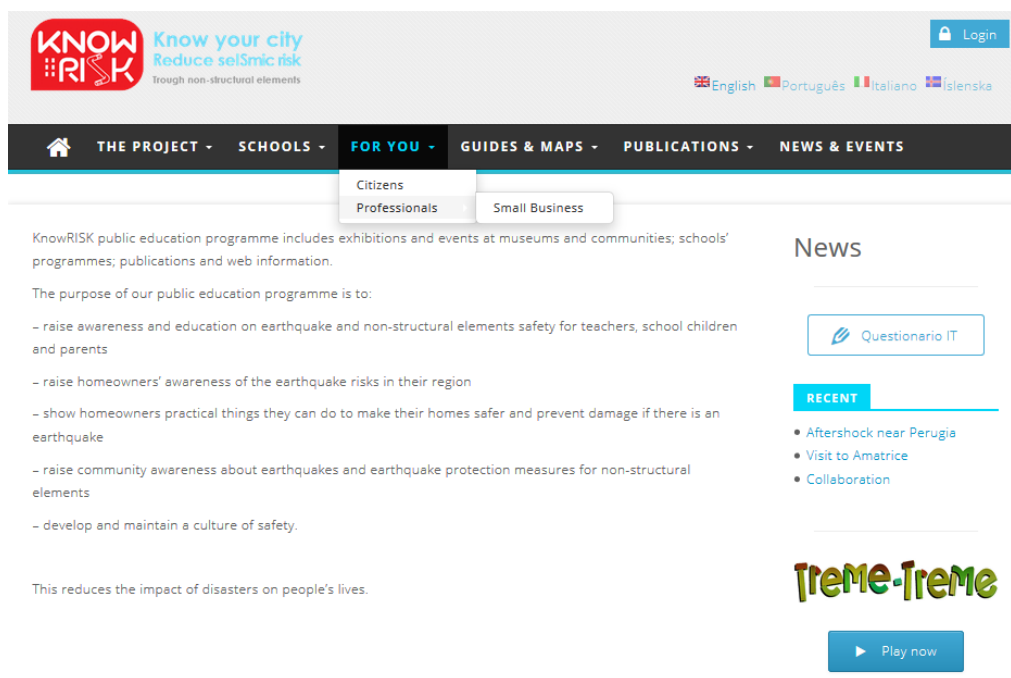


Figure 4. For You page

Figure 4 shows the “For You” page which contains information to raise homeowners’ awareness of the earthquake risks in their region; show homeowners practical things they can do to make their homes safer and prevent damage if there is an earthquake and to raise community awareness about earthquakes and earthquake protection measures for non-structural elements.

- Citizens - in this area exists three subcategories: Know your building; Know your neighbourhood (RiskMAP) and the Practical Guide
- Professionals end-users: engineers, architects, building constructors - in this area professionals have access to the Portfolio.

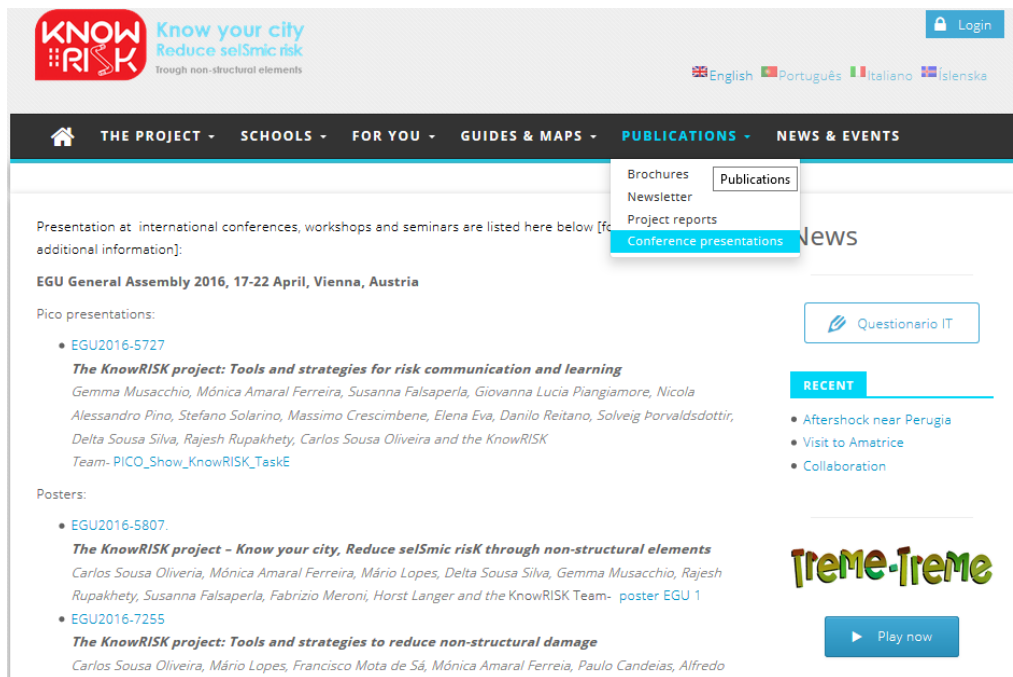


Figure 5. Publication page / Conference presentations

These documents may be disseminated outside the consortium. By clicking on the folder everyone could visualize and download the documents content (Figure 5).

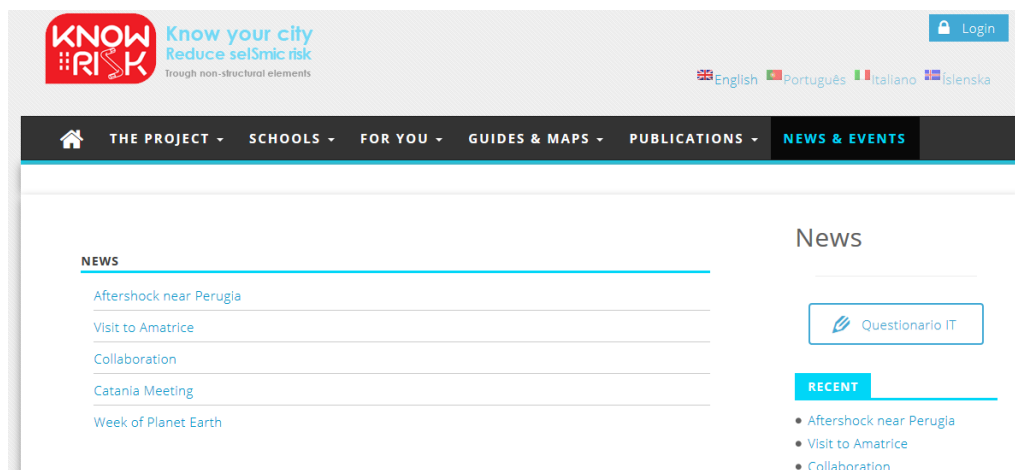


Figure 6. News & Events page

Figure 6 shows the “News and Events” page which contains information on current or past.
